

# Søren Kierkegaard Literature 1992-1993. A Bibliography

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## Preface

The present compilation of literature on Søren Kierkegaard updates the following publications: [1] *Søren Kierkegaard-litteratur 1961-1970: En foreløbig bibliografi*, Århus, 1971; [2] *Søren Kierkegaard-litteratur 1971-1980: En bibliografi*, Århus, 1983 (repaginated off-print from *Kierkegaardiana*, 12, 1982, pp. 129-235); [3] "Søren Kierkegaard Literature 1981-1991: A Bibliography", in *Kierkegaardiana*, 16, 1993, pp. 166-239.

The compilation was made to a great extent on the basis of current bibliographies. Whenever possible, entries were verified by checking the works in question. Entries which could not be verified in this way are marked with an asterisk, in which case the source is normally one of the following bibliographies: *MLA International Bibliography*; *International Philosophical Bibliography*; *The Philosopher's Index*; *Religion Index One/Periodicals*; *Religion Index Two/Multi-Author Works*; *Humanities Index*.

Calvin D. Evans' *Søren Kierkegaard Bibliographies: Remnants, 1944-1980, and Multi-Media, 1925-1991*, Montreal, 1993, called my attention to some omissions in the three bibliographies mentioned above. Those missing items have now been included. For books and articles I could not personally verify, the Evans number is quoted in [ ].

The material is ordered alphabetically according to author's name. In cases where several contributions are listed for one author, those entries are placed in chronological order. Critiques, reviews, etc., are generally listed along with the works with which they deal. Collections are (with a few exceptions) treated in the same way as other books and alphabetized according to the name of the editor.
