

the 20th century, causing significant shifts in the political and educational landscape. The 1918-1919 influenza epidemic, which claimed over 50,000 lives in Canada, had a profound impact on the country's public health infrastructure. It led to the establishment of the Canadian National Institute of Hygiene (CNIH) in 1920, which became the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR) in 1993. This shift in focus from communicable diseases to chronic conditions has been a defining characteristic of Canadian public health policy since the 1960s. The 1970s saw the introduction of the National Health Transfer Fund (NHTF), which provided significant funding to provinces and territories for health care delivery and infrastructure development. This funding was instrumental in expanding access to health services across the country, particularly in rural and remote areas. In the 1980s and 1990s, the Canadian government shifted its focus towards a more market-oriented approach to health care, leading to the privatization of some services and the introduction of managed competition. This period also saw the emergence of new health issues, such as mental health, addictions, and long-term care, which required a more integrated and holistic approach to health policy. The 2000s brought significant challenges related to aging populations, chronic diseases, and the need for health system reform. The government responded by investing in primary care, preventive health, and long-term care services. The 2010s saw the introduction of the Canada Health Infrastruc-

ture Fund (CHIF), which provided significant investment in health infrastructure, including hospitals, clinics, and public health facilities. The government also focused on addressing social determinants of health, such as poverty, discrimination, and environmental factors, through programs like Healthy Communities and the Social Determinants of Health Strategy. The 2020s have brought new challenges related to mental health, addictions, and the impact of climate change on health. The government has responded by investing in mental health services, harm reduction programs, and climate change mitigation efforts.
