


Create a new version of an already published article

It happens that an editorial team, after publishing an issue, discovers an error in one of the published articles and therefore wishes to adapt the content of the article. If there are significant changes, you have to create a new version. This can now be solved in an easy way with OJS 3.2. After opening the article in edit mode, you will see the following under the **Publication** tab:
